Candidates may submit a statement to be included with ballot material. Only statements which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by 12 midday Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 21/08/2025 can be accepted.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 12/09/2025 and close at 10:00am Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 16/10/2025.
