Q#	Action	What it means in plain English
1	Work stoppages	We stop all work for a defined period.
2	Speaking out	We take short breaks from work to share information about our bargaining campaign.
3	Wearing campaign material	We wear AEU campaign t-shirts, badges, or other campaign material at work.
4	Email signature	We add a campaign message to the signature block of all work emails.
5	Ban on professional learning	We don't participate in directed professional learning activities.
6	Ban on exercising delegated powers	School leaders don't perform duties and exercise powers delegated to them by the Head of the ACTPS or the Director-General.
7	Ban on student reporting	We don't complete some or all aspects of student reporting.
8	Ban on SCIF activities	We don't participate in any activity associated with the Student-Centred Improvement Framework.
9	Stoppages during ALP MLA visits	We don't host an ACT Labor MLA visit to our school.
10	Ban on implementing new system initiatives	We don't implement new Directorate programs, initiatives, or reforms.
11	Ban on split/collapsed classes	We don't take students from classes being split or collapsed due to teacher absence.
12	Ban on exceeding class sizes	We don't teach a class where student numbers exceed the Class Sizes Policy.
13	Work-to-rule	We do only what's required by our position description, nothing extra.
14	Ban on Directorate promotional work	We don't participate in public promotion of the Directorate.
15	Ban on Directorate-directed meetings	We don't attend meetings convened by the Directorate.
16	Ban on data, surveys, and audits	We don't complete data collection, surveys, audits, or compliance reporting initiated by the Directorate.
